mountain to cool their heels in Moose Pond.

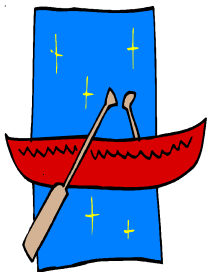

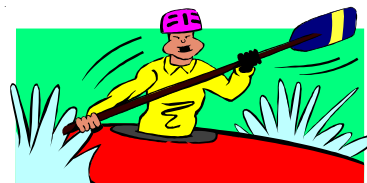
Carrigan but had to retreat back to their campsite late in the afternoon. They returned to camp vowing to revisit this mountain again.
