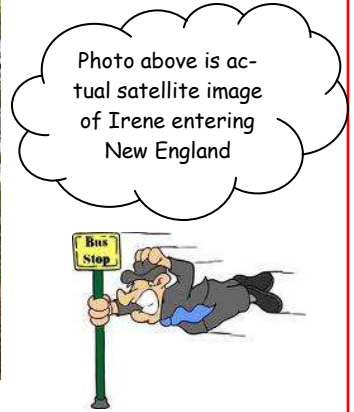

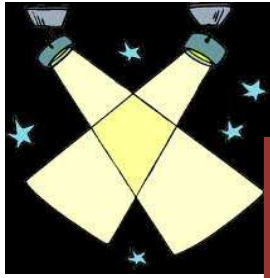

A few excerpts from nice notes:

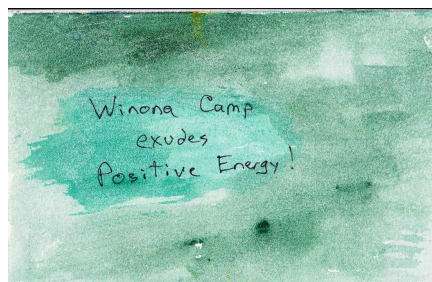
Taran Daly: "Thank you for another wonderful year at Winona. I really enjoyed it."
